

New Course Adoption

Policy #5032

In keeping with its responsibility of establishing and maintaining an adequate program of education for students, the Torrington Board of Education shall provide coursework that leads to quality performance within articulated curriculum standards in all learning areas.

The Assistant Superintendent shall review proposals for new courses.

New course proposals found to be acceptable by the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent shall be presented to the School Improvement and Community Relations Committee for review and submitted to the Board of Education for implementation.

At the discretion of the Superintendent, new courses shall be brought forward to the Board of Education for adoption. Any course that has a budgetary impact must be approved by the Board of Education prior to the presentation of the Superintendent's Proposed Budget.
