4. Presentations – Mr. Arum presented information on the timeline for a school construction grant and bonding process. If a referendum is approved and the application is submitted by June 2020, the project may be completed by 2024-25, best case scenario. Mayor Carbone and Dan Farley-City Treasurer addressed questions on the bonding and referendum process and encouraged the Ad Hoc Committee to educate the public on the benefits of the proposed renovate to new and possible addition project for THS. The current 5 year bond on City projects is \$7 million a year and will phase out when the school project is implemented. Several Tax abatements will as well putting the City in a good position to bond the project.
